

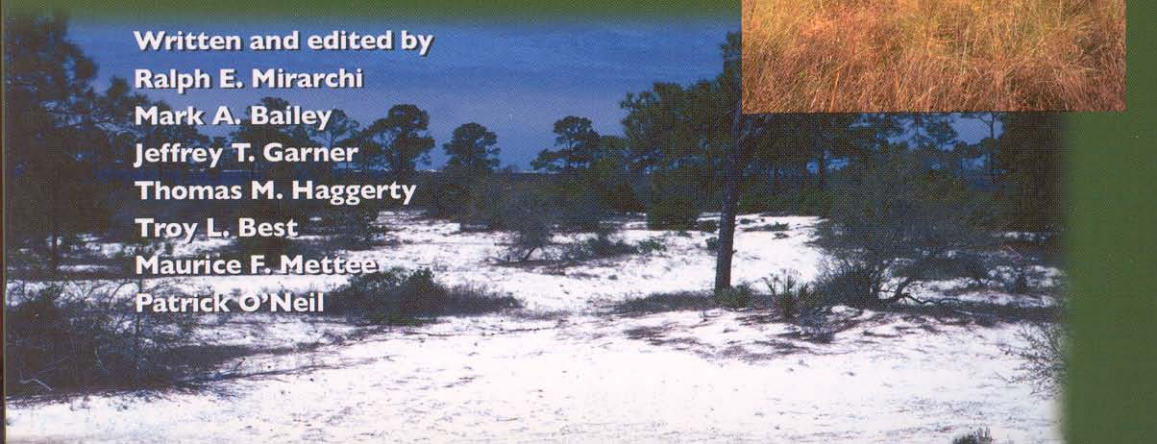
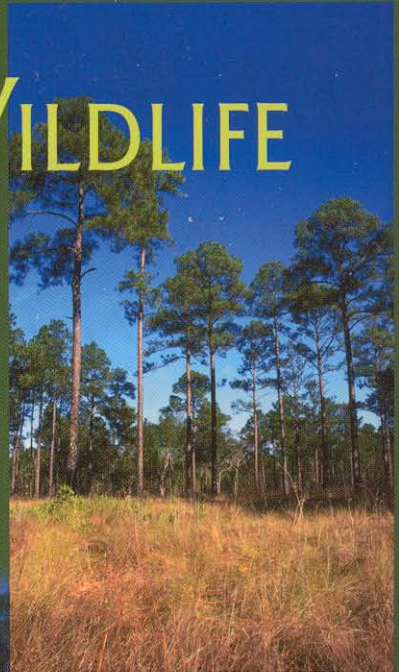

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LITTLE BROWN MYOTIS

Myotis lucifugus (LeConte)

Field studies are needed to assess distribution and ecology of this species in Alabama. Because abundance of this species seems greater in the northern part of its distribution, surveys may need to focus on the northern half of the state. To assess whether populations may be in jeopardy in Alabama, intensive sampling with mist nets and bat traps, cave surveys, and locating and assessing maternity roosts are recommended.

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
