

## PRESIDENTIAL GRADUATE FELLOWSHIPS IN THE COLLEGE OF EDUCATION 2002-2003

The College of Education is pleased to assist our doctoral students with Presidential Graduate Fellowships, given through the Graduate School at Auburn University. These fellowships are available for College of Education doctoral students who will hold a non-teaching assistantship during the 2002-2003 academic year. Students with teaching assistantship are already covered by Auburn University's GTA tuition-waiver program. The fellowships will provide in-state tuition for one year and are renewable a second year for students who are making good progress toward their degrees. First consideration for these fellowships will be given to GRAs with research assistantship assignments.

To apply for one of these fellowships, please submit the following material to Dr. Frances Kochan, 3084 Haley Center, by **July 15, 2002**:

1. Letter of application, stating your interest and qualifications for the fellowship. Include a description of the work you do or will do on your assistantship.
2. Copies of graduate and undergraduate transcripts.
3. At least one letter of recommendation from a faculty member who is familiar with your work.
4. If you have held an assistantship in the past year, a letter from your major professor or supervisor of your assistantship, addressing the quality of your work on that assistantship.
5. Your *Curriculum Vitae*.
6. Copies of papers or articles authored or co-authored or a sample of your recent professional writing.
7. Any other documentation related to your research activity (grant proposals, reports, instruments, etc.)
8. Other material that represents the quality of your academic and professional work.
9. Other financial assistantships or fellowships, please indicate.
