TB TEST REQUIREMENT

Students must provide negative results of a tuberculin skin test (or X-ray) as prerequisite to any laboratory/field experiences in some school systems and as prerequisite to the internship experience in all school systems. The test results must be less than one year old for the internship and may be presented to the assigned school system no later than the first day of the internship. (Test results may be considered valid by some systems for up to three years if required for laboratory experiences other than the internship. Students may check with their advisors or personnel in the Professional Education Services Office, 3464 Haley Center, regarding current TB test requirements.)

LIABILITY COVERAGE

Laboratory experiences are an important component of the teacher preparation program. Many of those experiences take place in a school or other educational institution and involve direct contact with pupils. Because any direct work with clients has the potential for involvement in a lawsuit, it is necessary for College of Education students to be protected by liability insurance coverage. Students will be billed for this insurance by the Bursar's Office along with other fees each semester they are enrolled in any class which could require a lab in the schools. Evidence of fee payment for the semester will suffice as verification of coverage.

ASSURANCE OF COMPETENCE

The College of Education at Auburn University will guarantee the success of graduates who receive their initial professional certification through the College and who are employed within their area(s) of specialization. The College will provide remediation at no cost to an individual who was recommended for certification by the College of Education and whose job performance within two years after program completion is deemed unsatisfactory by a local education agency based on performance evaluations established by the State Board of Education.
