

PACT ABROAD FACTS

1. When a student studies abroad, PACT pays Auburn tuition and fees for the semester, based on the number of hours of Auburn credit the student will take abroad.
2. PACT has instructed that Certification Letters completed by the student for PACT payment be sent all at one time to PACT and the Auburn Bursar by OIE/Auburn Abroad - about two weeks after the beginning of each semester – we cannot send them sooner.
3. Payment from PACT goes directly into a student's Bursar account and stays there as credit unless there are outstanding charges to be paid or a request is on file from the student to send the funds to their home address.
4. Students must pay program costs directly as required by the program director/provider and get PACT funding back later in the semester.
5. PACT payment for on-campus courses is paid in the same manner as payment for study abroad programs. The only difference is that program costs must be paid in advance for study abroad to secure travel, study, and living arrangements for students, so students have to pay prior to the beginning of the program.
