Requirements of Auburn Abroad Program: (APPLICATION DEADLINE: 3 mos. Prior to program start if VISA needed)

- All AU students (undergraduate and graduate) studying or interning abroad on an AU Faculty-led program or a program with another university, affiliate or service provider, are required to be enrolled in Auburn Abroad (AA includes MEDEX/ Global Enrollment, AU credit/grade posting, predeparture sessions, Global Tiger designation, etc).
- GPA of 2.5 Undergraduate, 3.0 GPA for Graduate Students. Applicant must also adhere to chosen program's requirements.
- Applicants must not have any pending judicial actions (acad/non-acad.) & must be in good standing with AU (acad/non-acad.).
- Minimum Age 19 by start date of program.
- Completion and submission of ALL Auburn Abroad Paperwork to AU on or before deadlines. **MUST ALSO ATTACH ACCEPTANCE LETTER FROM PROGRAM.** NOTE: if going on an AU faculty led program, AU program director gets originals, AU OIE will get copies from AU program director, otherwise, AU OIE gets all originals.
- Continue to carry Domestic insurance of \$250,000 per accident or illness, while abroad.
- Payment of AA fee for each program Abroad billed through AU Bursar, check with OIE for current fee amount.
- Payment of Program Abroad fees as specified by your chosen program.
- Grades from approved courses (listed on AA FORM B) and approved programs are posted as AU credit upon receipt of transcript from the program. You must give your chosen program the AA TRANSCRIPT REQUEST FORM, prior to the beginning of your program abroad. S/U designation allowed only upon approval, in writing, from Academic/faulty Advisor in Major.
