## Emergency Plan – Student Responsibilities

In the case of a medical emergency:

- If safe, go back to your residence right away.
- Keep your phone lines clear, wait for info from faculty leader-program.
- Keep informed of local events via radio, TV
- If you are going to a hospital, have someone call program director and MEDEX – keep them informed of your situation
- Your situation will be kept confidential.
- MEDEX will contact family members for you.
- Keep all receipts in case a healthcare provider abroad does not accept the MEDEX/Global financial guarantee. These receipts can be sent to Global benefits. Best case: \$100 deductible.
