SUBJECT: MedEx Costs

After reviewing the issue of how we cover costs for Med-Ex insurance, I conclude we should discontinue the central funding approach currently in place. I say this knowing personally the benefits of the Med-Ex insurance, and knowing that the Fisher Report urges that we assist with costs of international travel.

The annual cost on the order of \$60,000 to \$100,000 is substantial, and I believe the costs should be borne by the individual units rather than central funding. My understanding is that we will need to re-do the RAIT to include an account number or check that a personal check is attached.
