## College of Business

- Auburn University's College of Business ranked **30<sup>th</sup>** nationally among public institutions and **52<sup>nd</sup>** overall in the **2009 U.S. News & World Report** rankings. This is the **sixth** consecutive year that the College of Business has attained a top 40 rating among public schools.
- The college and the School of Accountancy are accredited at the undergraduate and graduate levels by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB International). Less than one-third of U.S. business schools and only 15 percent of business schools worldwide meet the rigorous standards of AACSB International accreditation.
- The Aviation and the Aviation Management-Professional Flight programs are accredited by the Council on Aviation Accreditation (CAA). AU is one of only 19 academic institutions in the nation with a fully accredited aviation program.
- AU School of Accountancy graduates ranked 8<sup>th</sup> among all schools where first-time candidates without advanced degrees took and passed all sections of the exam, according to results published in 2008 by the National Association of State Boards of Accountancy for the 2006 Uniform CPA Examination.
- The TIGER (Trading, Investing, & Global Economic Research) Lab is a state-of-the-art investment center in the Lowder Business Building where students get hands-on experience in securities analysis and decision-making in both real and simulated environments.
- The Office of Professional and Career Development was established in 2009 to prepare business students for successfully entering and excelling in the workplace. The office's location in the Lowder Business Building will centralize recruiting, career education, and professional development.
- More than **\$580,000** in scholarships and awards were presented to undergraduate and graduate students for the **2008-2009** academic year.
