Drop Off Information:

On the *first day of camp*, park in the parking deck located on the corner of Duncan Drive and Roosevelt Concourse. Please display the enclosed pick up pass on your car dash to avoid receiving a ticket. Bring your child to **Parker Hall Room 236** starting at 8:00am. Please **do not drop your child off on the first day**. We need to ensure that your child is appropriately registered and that we have your child's completed medical release form on file. A brief parent information session will begin at 8:20am. This will be a critical time for you to find out about any last minute announcements including the "pick up" and "drop off" location for the remainder of camp.

On *subsequent days of camp*, you may drop your child off at the drop off point (location will be provided on the first morning of camp) **no earlier than 8:00am**. A camp counselor will be at this location from 8:00am-8:15am. If you are late dropping off your child and a camp counselor is no longer present please call Jesse Daniel at 334-734-8506 (cell) to ensure that your child makes it to his/her first course. Do not leave your child at the drop off location if a camp counselor is not present.

Pick up Information:

Please be sure to pick up your child no later than 4:45pm. If an emergency situation arises which prevents you from being on time to pick up your child please call the Summer YES Camp Director, Erin Edmondson at 913-424-2797 (cell). Otherwise, an extended childcare fee of \$5.00 will be assessed beginning at 4:45pm for every fifteen minutes extra your child remains with us.

If you have made arrangements with another person to pick-up your child after camp or if you are planning to meet your child at another location on campus please bring a signed note to this effect to check-in on the first day of camp.

Closing Ceremony:

On the last day of camp we will have an informal certificate ceremony beginning at 4:45pm in Parker Hall room 307. Parents and family members are invited to attend. Don't forget your camera! You may park in the parking deck located at the corner of Duncan Drive and Roosevelt Concourse. Be sure to display the enclosed parking pass to avoid receiving a ticket. The ceremony should conclude no later than 5:30pm.

- Campers should wear comfortable walking or athletic shoes with closed toes for lab safety purposes and comfortable clothing that can get dirty (shorts, t-shirts, and tennis shoes)
- Those campers participating in the River Creatures course should be aware that on at least one day they will get dirty enough to warrant bringing a change of clothing. Your course instructor will advise you as to which day(s) to plan on bringing an extra set of clothes.
- Campers will receive a camp bag on the first day. They should keep all camp materials in the tote bag and bring it back each day.

What not to bring/wear to camp:

- All materials and supplies needed for each course (including pens, pencils, paper, etc.) will be provided; there is not reason to bring materials.
- All lunches, snacks, and drinks are provided during camp, so no extra spending money is necessary. Campers may have an opportunity to visit the Au Bookstore for students to purchase souvenirs one day. If this happens, we will inform the students the day before so they can bring extra money if they wish.
- Heelys®, skateboards, bikes, and other wheeled devices are not to be brought to camp.
- Hand-held gaming devices are prohibited.
- Campers should not wear open-toed shoes including flip-flops, Crocs®, or sandals due to Auburn University Lab Safety Policies.

Cell Phone Policy:

All courses are interactive and hands-on. Be aware that campers may take field trips and/or get wet or dirty during activities. Due to the nature of our camps, we do not encourage campers to bring cell phones. However, we understand that parents may feel more comfortable knowing their child is carrying a cell phone. For this reason, cell phones are allowed at all Summer YES Camps. **Campers must turn their cell phones off during all courses throughout the day.** If an emergency situation arises in which you need to immediately get in contact with your child, you may use the emergency contact information (provided below) and a camp representative will get you touch with your child. Auburn University is not responsible for cell phones that are lost or stolen during Summer YES Camps.
