Drop off Information:

On the *first day of camp*, park in the parking deck located on the corner of Duncan Dr. and Roosevelt Concourse. Please display the enclosed PICK UP PASS on your car dash to avoid receiving a ticket. **Bring** your child to **Parker Hall room 236 starting at 7:45am**. Please **do not drop your child off on the first day**. We need to ensure that your child is appropriately registered and that we have your child's completed medical release form on file. A brief parent information session will begin at 8:15am. We ask that all parents stay for the meeting as this is when you will find out any last minute announcements including the "pick up" and "drop off" location for the remainder of camp.

On *subsequent days of camp*, you may drop your child off at the drop off point (location will be provided on the first morning of camp) **no earlier than 8:00am**. A camp counselor will be at this location from 8:00am-8:15am. If you are late dropping off your child and a camp counselor is no longer present please call Jesse Daniel 334-734-8506 (cell) to ensure that your child makes it to his/her first course. Do not leave your child at the drop off location if a camp counselor is not present.

Pick up Information:

In order to ensure the safety of each camper we have provided you with a pick up pass unique to your child. Please display your child's pick up pass in the front, right-hand corner of your dash. If you are picking up multiple children, please be sure to display each child's pick up pass.

While we understand that many campers are familiar with the Auburn University campus, we cannot allow children to meet you at another location on-campus. An adult (over the age of 19), with your child's PICK UP PASS must be present to pick-up your child. If you have made arrangements with another person to pick-up your child after camp, bring a signed note to this effect to camp check-in on the first day of camp. Also, make sure that you give that person your child's pick up pass.

Please be sure to pick up your child no later than 3:30pm. If you know that you will be unable to pick-up your child on time you may pre-register your child(ren) for extended childcare services. To register, complete the Extended Childcare Services Form provided in this packet. If an emergency situation arises which prevents

you from being on time to pick up your child please call the Summer YES Director, Erin Edmondson at 913-424-2797 (cell). Otherwise, a fee of \$10.00 will be assessed.

Closing Ceremony:

On the *last day of camp* we will have an informal certificate ceremony beginning at 3:45 pm in **Parker Hall room 307**. It should conclude no later than 4:30pm. Parents and family members are invited to attend this ceremony. Don't forget your cameras! You may park in the parking deck located on the corner of Duncan Drive and Roosevelt Concourse. *Be sure to display your child's pick up pass to avoid receiving a ticket.*

- Campers should wear comfortable walking or athletic shoes with closed toes for lab safety purposes and comfortable clothing that can get dirty (Example: shorts, t-shirts, and tennis shoes).
- Campers will receive a camp tote bag on the first day of camp. They should keep all camp materials in the tote bag and bring it back each day.

What not to bring/wear to camp:

- All materials and supplies needed for each course (including pens, pencils, paper, etc.) will be provided; there is no reason to bring materials.
- All lunches, snacks, and drinks are provided during camp, so no extra spending money is necessary.
- Heelys®, skateboards, bikes, and other wheeled devices are not to be brought to camp.
- Hand-held gaming devices are prohibited.
- Campers should not wear open-toed shoes including flip-flops, Crocs®, or sandals due to Auburn University Lab Safety Policies.

Cell Phone Policy:

- All courses are interactive and hands-on. Be aware that campers may take field trips and/or get wet or dirty during activities. Due to the nature of our camps, we do not encourage campers to bring cell phones. However, we understand that parents may feel more comfortable knowing their child is carrying a cell phone. For this reason, cell phones are allowed at all Summer YES Camps. However, **campers must turn their cell phones off during all courses throughout the day.** If an emergency situation arises in which you need to immediately get in contact with your child, you may use the emergency contact information (provided above) and a camp representative will get you in touch with your child. Auburn University is not responsible for cell phones that are lost or stolen during Summer YES Camps.
