Criteria for the award: 1) **graduating senior in the Humanities** from Summer Semester 2021, Fall Semester 2021, and/or Spring Semester 2022; 2) outstanding scholarship; 3) honors and awards; 4) participation in Auburn University, community and professional activities; 4) personal qualities/character and 5) Eligibility for Phi Kappa Phi*
