The 32-foot "Green Giant" arborvitae currently holds more than 1,250 lights, 75 bows and 50 ornaments.

Facilities Management has been decorating the tree for about 12 years, each year requiring the service of about seven people who volunteer about 10 hours of their time to decorate the tree.

It's no small feat getting it ready for the holiday season. Bucket trucks are utilized to place bows and ornaments, as well as wrapping the lights around the tree itself.
