



AU Mammogram Day

**November 18, 2011
7:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.**



The program is available for employees and spouses covered under the AU Blue Cross Blue Shield insurance program.

Who is eligible:

- Participants of AU Blue Cross Blue Shield Insurance Program
- 35 years or older
- Individuals who have never had a mammogram
- Individuals who have not had a mammogram in the last two years

Not recommended for those who have implants.

There are 58 spots available, by appointment, on a first-come-first-serve basis.

If patients do not go to Lee-OB or Dr. Sharma, must use Dr. Kam from the AU Medical Clinic as referring doctor or have an order faxed to Colleen Alsobrook by November 14th from any other Doctor.

We encourage all those who have already scheduled their yearly mammogram to keep their appointment and allow these spaces to be used by those who are overdue. Just a reminder, AU insurance provides for an annual breast exam and mammogram. Time off will be allowed for the initial exam and if needed, the first round of additional testing. If further testing is recommended, the employee will be required to use their sick leave.



When making the appointment please have the following information available: BCBS#, Date of Birth, date of last mammogram, Social Security number, Phone number and the policy holders name. Please note that if the mammogram detects a possible problem and additional tests are required, employees will be required to pay the co-pay and deductibles related to the additional testing.

Mammograms will be done at Auburn Diagnostic, 1527 Professional Parkway.
