
- National benchmarking tool to assess level of LGBTQ+ inclusion on college campuses
- Provides foundation to improve LGBTQ+ inclusive policies, programs, and practices

What will the initiative consist of?

- CPI at Auburn will establish a leadership committee comprised of an undergraduate student, graduate student, faculty, and administrator who will lead efforts around 8 domains
- This approach will move these efforts forward in several areas simultaneously to institutionalize this cultural change across Auburn University

- 3. Academic Life
- 4. Student Life
- 5. Housing
- 6. Campus Safety
- 7. Counseling and Health
- 8. Recruitment and Retention Efforts
