


# Hill Residence Hall Complex



### FIVE YEAR CAPITAL PROJECT PLAN

### Five Year Plan Capital Project Plan:

- Provides a listing of planned projects for Execution in the Next Five Years.
- Provides a More Orderly Capital Project Execution Process
- Provides a Resource Constrained Plan
- Greater Emphasis on Prioritizing Projects
- Conveys the "Big Picture" of Capital Project Investment to the Board of Trustees and AU Campus
- Promotes Better, More Strategic Planning

### FIVE YEAR CAPITAL PROJECT PLAN

# The Five Capital Project Plan controls the following key University resources by:

- 1. Providing goals for the amount of gift funds to be obtained on capital projects.
- 2. Establishing the amount of <u>University reserves</u> to be utilized on capital projects.
- 3. Establishing the total amount of <u>bond borrowing</u> for capital projects.
- 4. Establishing the amount of annual <u>tuition increase revenue</u> that can be applied to pay the debt service on capital project bond funding.
