Job Summary

Coordinates and evaluates student eligibility for the payment of instate tuition by obtaining documentation of residency from interested parties and ensure appropriate residency classification is consistent with the Code of Alabama and Auburn University policy.

Essential Functions

- 1. Communicates in person, by phone, or email with students, parents, staff and other interested parties concerning residency information specific to their residency circumstance. Maintains residency website on the Office of the Registrar webpage.
- 2. Collects, evaluates, approves/denies, processes and records residency appeal documentation
- 3. Delivers presentations during the summer to parents and students at Camp War Eagle.
- 4. Prepares appeal packets for the Residency Committee. Schedules and conducts meetings and follows up with outcomes.
- 5. Provides annual report of Residency Committee activities, submits residency appeal documentation upon request to University and State auditors, provides statistics and spreadsheets to interested parties.

Supervisory Responsibility

May supervise employees but supervision is not the main focus of the job.

The above essential functions are representative of major duties of positions in this job classification. Specific duties and responsibilities may vary based upon departmental needs. Other duties may be assigned similar to the above consistent with the knowledge, skills and abilities required for the job. Not all of the duties may be assigned to a position.
