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### Job Summary

Performs a variety of office support duties within an administrative department.

### Essential Functions

1. Acts as office receptionist: receives and routes telephone calls and visitors; provides and gathers information.
2. Prepares documents, reports, newsletters and manuscripts, and may compose correspondence.
3. Operates standard office equipment such as personal computers, copiers, scanners, fax machines, etc.
4. Maintains inventory and orders office supplies, materials and equipment.
5. Processes and prepares forms such as work orders, purchase orders and personnel documents.
6. Creates and maintains records, files, documents, and images in the data system.
7. Calculates, posts, and verifies standard financial statements, reports and vouchers.
8. May perform other office support duties such as payroll processing, document processing, and assisting with financial services.

### Supervisory Responsibility

May be responsible for training, assisting or assigning tasks to others. May provide input to performance reviews of other employees.
