#### **Job Summary**

Responsible for performing daily care of multiple animal species and for ensuring animal housing facilities are supplied appropriately for animal care, research and teaching activities.

#### **Essential Functions**

- 1. Ensures animal cages and/or containment rooms are kept clean and orderly. Restocks supplies needed for cleaning rooms and meeting care animal needs.
- 2. May perform a variety of animal care duties including but not limited to feeding, watering, monitoring basic animal health and behavior, cage change out and cleaning of kennels.
- 3. May perform a variety of animal care facility services including but not limited to upkeep and maintenance of animal housing areas such as but not limited to sweeping, mopping, sanitization of walls, floors, tables, and equipment.
- 4. Assists with animal treatment and health needs on an as needed.
- 5. Assists with quality assurance and reports mechanical or physical plant issues.
- 6. May perform a variety of duties in animal support areas including but not limited to laundry, cleaning and sterilizing equipment and loading and unloading supply racks.
- 7. Adherence and understanding of biosecurity protocols including but not limited to wearing correct personal protective equipment (PPE), stocking of PPE, and maintaining footbaths.
- 8. Performs other duties as assigned.

#### **Supervisory Responsibility**

May be responsible for training, assisting or assigning tasks to others. May provide input to performance reviews of other employees.

The above essential functions are representative of major duties of positions in this job classification. Specific duties and responsibilities may vary based upon departmental needs. Other duties may be assigned similar to the above consistent with the knowledge, skills and abilities required for the job. Not all of the duties may be assigned to a position.

#### **Minimum Required Education and Experience**

include at least 2 years at the preceding level or equivalent.

Level III High school diploma or equivalent plus 4 years of relevant experience. Experience must

include at least 2 years at the preceding level or equivalent.

#### Focus of Education Focus of Experience

High School Diploma or equivalent. Experience in animal care and husbandry practices.

#### Substitutions allowed for Education:

Indicated education is required; no substitutions allowed.

#### **Substitutions allowed for Experience:**

When a candidate has the required education, but lacks the required experience, they may normally apply additional appropriate education toward the experience requirement, at a rate of one (1) year relevant education per year of required experience.

#### Minimum Required Knowledge

#### **Certification or Licensure Requirements:**

Valid driver's license required. Some positions may require Assistant Laboratory Animal Technician (ALAT), Laboratory Animal Technician (LAT), and/or Laboratory Animal Technologist (LATG). Some positions may require the ability to obtain AALAS certifications once hired.

## Physical Requirements/ADA
