

ADVISEMENT SCHEDULE – SUMMER AND FALL 2012

Cater (OUS –Academic Counseling and Advising Center) and IDSC (Interdisciplinary Studies)

Students, if you have previously been advised in Cater, you will need to plan ahead and call 844-7277 for an appointment or see walk-in times below. If you have never been to the Cater Center for advising, and have been referred, come to 113 Cater Hall immediately. You will not walk in and see the Advisor and get your PIN # on your first appointment. This process can take up to 3 weeks; do not wait until the last minute!!

Expanded walk-in times are available for established Cater and declared IDSC Students starting the week of February 27th through March 30th. **DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE WEEK YOU NEED TO REGISTER!!!! PLAN TO MEET AT LEAST TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO YOUR TIME TICKET.**

A registration block will be placed on ALL undergraduate KINE students. In addition, all teacher education majors falling below a 2.5 cumulative GPA are required to participate in mandatory academic coaching. All other academic advising is strongly encouraged.

The department will maintain the holds for courses that require Admission to Teacher Education as a Prerequisite.

Curriculum and Teaching – PES Advisor and Faculty Advisor

Freshmen and Sophomores.....Anytime by appointment
Students may make an appointment with their PES Advisor using SARS, an online appointment system found in the student section of our college's website. Students required to participate in program specific advising will be notified individually. Faculty advisors are available during their posted office hours or through scheduled appointments made via email.

Juniors and Seniors.....February 22 – February 24
Students are encouraged to check with their assigned faculty advisor regarding available appointments. Some faculty advisors will have sign-up sheets posted on their door.

Kinesiology – Advising appointments will be scheduled with Tina Gottesman

Advising is MANDATORY for ALL undergraduate KINE students. Students are required to attend academic advising in order to have their PIN reset for registration. Appointments will be available in thirty minute increments from 9-11:00 am and 1:30-4:00 pm most weekdays. Students may schedule an appointment by going to the Advising page (under "Students") of the Department of Kinesiology website.

Please be considerate of other students' priority in registration and ONLY schedule an advising appointment on or after YOUR advising date. Appointments can be scheduled 2 weeks in advance. Check daily for available appointments on or after your advising date. Appointments during this time should ONLY be for Summer/Fall Registration Advising! Any other issues/questions should be initiated through email with Robin Martin and/or Tina Gottesman.

Exercise Science applications are due in COLSM 2047 no later than 4:30 pm on Monday, January 30, 2012 (15th class day). Physical Education/Teacher Education interviews will be held in Spring AND Fall.

The Department of Kinesiology will not process transient permission requests until February 29. Students are advised to register for any class(es) they intend to take at Auburn BEFORE they request transient permission for classes to be taken elsewhere.

SCHOOL OF FORESTRY AND WILDLIFE SCIENCES
