Auburn will begin processing Fall 2008 applications on June 1, 2007. Transfer applicants are encouraged to apply by January 1, 2008, for Fall 2008 admission. Consideration for admission requires approximately six weeks with the first admissions decisions mailed on October 1 and on a rolling basis thereafter. Once your application is received, you will receive an application acknowledgement in approximately one week (holidays excluded). You will receive important Auburn updates frequently. If you have any questions during the application process, please contact the Office of Admissions and Recruitment. Please Note: Admission to Auburn constitutes acceptance to the University. Some academic areas require a second application process (after completion of the core curriculum requirements) in order to move from the "pre" curricular classes into the formal academic program.

After you have been accepted, we must receive your admission deposit before we can reserve your place. The admissions deposit is due by May 1 and is non-refundable. In addition to holding your place, all accepted students, including scholarship students, must submit the admission deposit in order to receive information about university housing or to register for the summer orientation program, Camp War Eagle.

The Freshman Scholarship priority deadline is December 1.

Please note the following applicant information:

- > **Freshman:** Students who are currently attending or who have graduated from high school. In addition to requested credentials listed on the application cover, students must submit a final transcript after high school graduation. In addition to an evaluation of core classes, Auburn will consider your high school grade point average (GPA), ACT and/or SAT scores, and the additional information required on the back of this application.
- > **Transfer:** Students who have enrolled for a credit level course at another college or university after graduating from high school. Exceptions are those withdrawing from college with no academic record or those attempting coursework during the summer following graduation from high school.
- > **Auditor:** Students who attend classes for no academic credit.
- > **Transient:** Visiting students who wish to transfer Auburn academic credit to their primary college or university.
- > **Joint Enrollment:** Students who are seeking joint (simultaneous) enrollment at Auburn University and their high school. Such students will have completed their junior year in high school and wish to take college courses. Permission is needed from the high school principal or counselor and a parent/guardian.
- > **Early Admission:** Students who wish to forego part of their high school curriculum and apply for admission to the university with permission of their high school principal or counselor and a parent/guardian. For Early Admission requirements, please call the Office of Admissions and Recruitment at 334-844-6425.
- > **Unclassified:** Students who are taking classes as prerequisites for another program or students who have completed their bachelor's degree and are taking post-Baccalaureate courses. Students must submit a copy of their college diploma or proof of their undergraduate degree.

After your application is complete, be on the lookout for:

- > **Housing Information:** The Office of Housing and Residence Life will notify all accepted freshmen of the opportunity to apply for university housing following receipt of their admissions deposit. Applications for housing are completed on-line. Housing space is limited, so if you are interested in living on campus, you are encouraged to make application as soon as possible.
- > **Financial Aid:** It is recommended that you complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov as soon as your family receives all of their tax information. The student financial aid priority deadline is March 1.
- > **Scholarships:** The Freshman Scholarship priority deadline is December 1. Application materials should be postmarked by this date to receive automatic consideration for Freshman Scholarships and General Scholarships. The Transfer Scholarship priority deadline is June 1. Students must be accepted for admission by this date to receive automatic consideration for Transfer Scholarship. Some Departmental Scholarships may require a separate application.
