The initiative will deploy 1,000 new computer workstations and replace nearly 500 more at 94 rural libraries and 21 public schools across Alabama. The project will provide Alabama libraries and schools with a detailed evaluation of their technological needs and service options. It will also deploy at least 20 audio-visual conference facilities at these Public Computer Center (PCC) locations, and instal Wi-Fi networks that will expand wireless broadband Internet access at approximately 30 PCCs.
