<b>Award Description</b> The purpose of this study is to examine whether the manner in which parents interact with their preschool children and parents' and children's responses to stress, in combination with how they think about stressful social situations, influence the child's health and social adjustment. Responses to stress are being measured with physical responses, including changes in heart rate and stress-hormone levels. We expect that parents and children whose physical responses to pleasant situations are coordinated will be healthier and better socially adjusted. We expect that children with very low physical stress responses will have more problems with aggression, whereas those who have strong physical responses to stress will be more likely to worry or be depressed, and that the predictions will be
