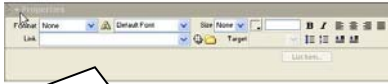




Step 1



The Properties Inspector at the bottom of Dreamweaver is a versatile tool. Depending on what is selected in Dreamweaver, the Properties Inspector will change, giving the appropriate options. It can also be hidden by clicking the arrow at the top left.

Step 2



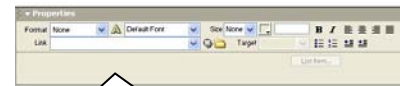
If a picture is selected, the Properties Inspector will look similar to this. Here, the size, location, hyperlink, and miscellaneous settings may be changed.

Step 3



You can also use Properties Inspector with an image to create an Image Map. An Image Map is a Hot Spot on an image that is associated with a hyperlink. For more information on Hot Spots, see the corresponding tipsheet.

Step 4



If text is selected, the Properties Inspector changes into a tool very similar to Microsoft's Word. Using the same commands as in Word, the text may be bolded, italicized, centered, etc.
