STUDENT ELIGIBILITY:

The program is open to the 2nd Year Industrial Design students first and then to other industrial design students, if space is available. The maximum number of students is 16 and the minimum GPA requirement is 2.50. If the maximum number is not filled we will consider students with a GPA less than 2.50 – this will be based on the Ireland Committee approval. Graduate students are welcome if space is available. In some cases graduate students may be given priority if their assistance is needed in teaching and leading the group.

DURATION: 10 weeks - approximate

The group will depart late February or early March and return at the end of the spring semester, which is around the first of May. Actual dates are being developed now – this depends on the availability of the schools and colleges that we visit in Ireland, Northern Ireland, Scotland and England.

CLASSES:
