

How to Apply for AU Music Education Graduate Degree Programs and Non-Degree Admissions

All applicants must:

- Complete an E-Application at www.grad.auburn.edu (click “Apply Online” and E-Application).
 - Create your own Login In and PIN at “First Time User Account Creation.”
 - Complete all sections, choosing a “Planned Course of Study” from “Education, Music Education.”
 - Pay the fee using a credit card.
- Order one official transcript of all undergraduate and any graduate credits from each school previously attended be sent to Auburn University Graduate School, 106 Hargis Hall, Auburn University, AL 36849.
- Take the Graduate Record Examination General Test (see www.gre.org) and have scores sent to Auburn University. (Auburn University's ETS institution code is 1005.) *NOTE: Non-degree seeking students do NOT have to have GRE scores for one-semester admission.*
- Request three current letters of recommendation from academic or professional references be sent to Dr. Nancy Barry, Head, Department of Curriculum and Teaching, 5040 Haley Center, Auburn University, AL 36849.
- Send your brief current résumé to Dr. Nancy Barry, Head, Department of Curriculum and Teaching, 5040 Haley Center, Auburn University, AL 36849.
- Send a copy of current teacher certification to Dr. Nancy Barry, Head, Department of Curriculum and Teaching, 5040 Haley Center, Auburn University, AL 36849.

Additionally, Ph.D. applicants must:

- Send statement of purpose (maximum, three pages) discussing (a) reasons for wishing to pursue the doctoral degree and (b) current professional or research interests to documents to Dr. Nancy H. Barry, Head, Department of Curriculum and Teaching, 5040 Haley Center, Auburn University, AL 36849.

Additionally, International applicants must:

- Send scores from Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or International English Language Testing System (IELTS) exam. (Auburn University's ETS institution code is 1005.)
- Demonstrate full financial sponsorship, proof of a comprehensive medical insurance plan and submit an Official Statement of Financing for International Students Form at http://www.grad.auburn.edu/forms/intl_instruct.html (\$50 fee).

Questions About Application Status

- Check email at the address you provided in your E-Application for notices from currgpo@auburn.edu.
- Check status of admission results at www.grad.auburn.edu (click “Apply Online” and E-Application) using the own Login In and PIN you created at application.
- Check postal mail at the address you provided in your E-Application for advising information from the Department of Curriculum and Teaching if you are admitted.

Application Deadlines

To ensure application processing for summer enrollment, all materials must be received by April 1. We will try to process applications completed after April 1 for summer admission but admission may be delayed to summer of the following year.

How to Apply for Transient Student Status

A graduate student in good standing at an accredited college or university may be admitted as a **transient** when faculty and facilities are available. Students **currently pursuing** a graduate degree and those who have actually **completed** their graduate degrees are eligible for this status. Transient status is **granted for one semester only** and does not constitute admission or matriculation as a degree candidate. Students who desire to enroll for more than a single semester in a non-degree status should apply for GND (graduate non-degree) status.
