

Special Learners in Music Education Workshop

This workshop will be taught by nationally-known music education-special education professor, Dr. Alice Hammel. The workshop is June 23 & June 24, 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. in Haley Center Room 1408. Special Learners in Music focuses on methods and techniques for meeting the needs of special learners in music classrooms. This workshop will feature hands-on demonstrations of music lessons that accommodate diverse learners and practical applications that work in real school settings.

Special Learners in Music Education Graduate Course

Dr. Hammel will also be teaching a 3-hour online graduate course this summer (CTMU 7976 section MU2). Students enrolled in the online course will also attend the workshop but do NOT pay the \$50 workshop fee. Tuition for the online course is \$1140 and may be paid at AU's "E-Bill" system after enrolling in the course. If you are a full-time residential AU student this summer (enrolled in at least 9 hours), you may choose to take the 3 credit hour course at the on-campus tuition rate (CTMU 7970 section 002).

You may enroll in the course as transient graduate student, an AU graduate student, a graduate non-degree seeking student or an AU undergraduate student. (Please see the graduate course enrollment flyer for information.) Applications for graduate course credit are due by May 1.
