MISSION

ALDOT's mission is to provide a safe, efficient, environmentally sound intermodal transportation system for all users, especially the taxpayers of Alabama. STRUCTURE

The Department is organized into nine geographic regions called Divisions, with a Central Office located in Montgomery. The Central Office is organized into the Office of the Transportation Director and the Office of the Chief Engineer with Bureaus and Divisions reporting to the Chief Engineer. Additionally, the department has several other boards and committees that operate either within a bureau or as a cooperative effort among several bureaus and/or divisions.

Alabama Service and Assistance Program (A.S.A.P) is a component of an overall Congestion Management Program designed to reduce traffic congestion on the regions interstate system and to improve air quality in the Greater Birmingham Area. To achieve this goal, A.S.A.P service trucks offer a variety of free services to disabled motorist to get them on the road again. A.S.A.P has assisted Alabama drivers, as well as drivers from across the United States, Canada, and many other nations.
