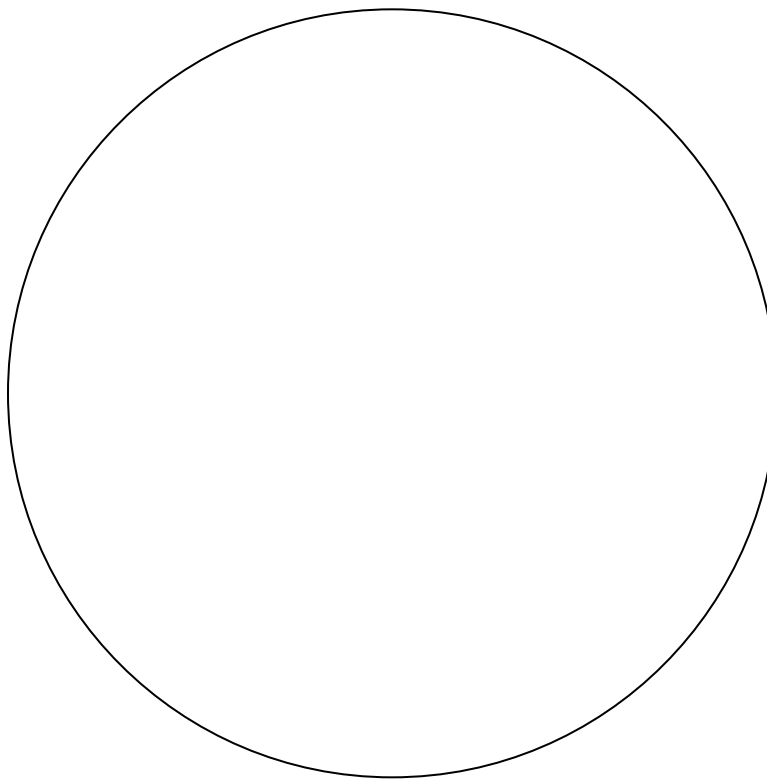

Why?: Every time it rains, stormwater drains away from our homes, yards, buildings, and roads where it has collected pollutants such as oil, lawn fertilizer, litter, and other waste. This water enters our storm drains, which then carry the water, untreated, to our creeks.

Help us educate other people in Auburn about the importance of not letting pollutants go down the storm drains and into our creeks!



Drain marker design: You can draw anything you want. Put your final design inside the circle above. This is exactly the size (4 inch diameter) of the actual markers.

Each marker design must have:

- 1) The name of your assigned creek watershed (listed above)
- 2) A phrase that lets people know that they should try to keep anything that can pollute our creeks from going down the storm drain.
(examples: "Keep it Clean" or "Only rain down the Drain" or "Don't pollute – Drains to our stream")

Colors: The background on the markers will be white and you can choose two other colors.
