

V. THE COMPETITIVE RESEARCH GRANT COMMITTEE

- A. The CRG Committee is composed of not less than nine (9) faculty members with research experience and an interest in the research programs of the University.
- B. Members of the Committee are appointed by the University Senate for a period of three (3) years.
- C. The VPR will serve as Chair.
- D. Representation on the Committee will include each College/School insofar as possible, and no two members will be from the same department.
- E. Members may be reappointed.
- F. **Sitting members cannot submit a CRG during their term.**
- G. The Committee will meet at least once a year;
 - 1. Special meetings may be called by the Chair when necessary;
 - 2. A majority of the members will constitute a quorum.
- H. The Committee will be divided into three subcommittees as follows:
 - 1. Subcommittee A: Science, Engineering and Mathematics;
 - 2. Subcommittee B: Medical and Behavioral Sciences and Education;
 - 3. Subcommittee C: Humanities, Fine Arts and Social Sciences;
 - 4. Each Subcommittee will appoint a subcommittee chair who will sit or one year unless they are willing to serve again.
- I. P.I.'s must choose which of the above subcommittees is most appropriate to review their proposals.
- D. The duties of the VPR/Chair will include:
 - 1. The issuance of the Request for Proposals to faculty including the deadline for submission;

2. Consultation with potential P.I.'s concerning proper writing of proposals;
3. The calling of and presiding at regular meetings and any necessary special meetings of the Committee;
4. The supervision of CRG grants expenditures, and consideration of requested budget modifications;
5. The review of requests for extension and final reports on projects supported by the program;
6. The maintenance of the permanent records pertinent to this Program.
