



## 2010-2011 Transfer Scholarships

### Available Scholarships

- ❖ A limited number of one-year, non-renewable Transfer Scholarships are awarded at three levels to transfer students who: (1) have achieved a minimum 3.25 transfer GPA; (2) have completed 30 transfer hours; and (3) are pursuing a first undergraduate degree. The minimum transfer GPA required for consideration at any level does not guarantee a scholarship will be awarded at that level.
- ❖ **Academic Excellence Scholarship**
  - Awarded up to tuition for Alabama residents and 2/3 tuition for non-residents.
  - Minimum 3.75 transfer GPA required for consideration.
- ❖ **Academic Achievement Scholarship**
  - Awarded at \$1,500.
  - Minimum 3.25 transfer GPA required for consideration.
- ❖ **Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship**
  - Awarded at \$2,500.
  - Minimum 3.75 transfer GPA.
  - Letter of nomination from the two-year college advisor confirming Phi Theta Kappa membership required for consideration.
  - Letter of nomination should be mailed to: Office of University Scholarships, 115 Quad Center, Auburn, AL 36849.

### Important Notes

- ❖ April 1 is the Transfer Scholarship priority deadline.
- ❖ Students accepted for admission by this date receive automatic consideration for Transfer Scholarships.
- ❖ The application for admission serves as the application for Transfer and General Scholarships. **A separate application is not required.**
- ❖ Students who enroll at Auburn for the spring or summer term will be considered for Transfer Scholarships with the students who plan to enroll for the upcoming fall term. Students enrolling summer term must be accepted for admission by April 1 to receive consideration.
- ❖ Financial need may also be a consideration when awarding Transfer Scholarships. Although not required, the majority of recipients selected demonstrate financial need.
- ❖ Tuition scholarship values are based on current tuition rates and will automatically adjust when funding is available. For specific tuition scholarship values, go to: [www.auburn.edu/scholarship](http://www.auburn.edu/scholarship).
- ❖ Students accepted for admission by February 1 with a minimum 3.0 transfer GPA receive automatic consideration for any General Scholarship for which they meet the criteria.
- ❖ Students should complete the FAFSA, available online beginning January 1, by March 1 each year to receive consideration for need-based scholarships.
