Become an AU-T4T educator and help spread awareness of locally endangered species. *Conservation education is gathering hearts to help protect the natural world.*

Earn your stripes by completing different stages of our program. At the end of every stage, you will receive a document that will be your ticket to the next stage. When you complete all 4 stages, you receive a diploma that will allow you go out and teach in name of AU-T4T. Wouldn't that look nice on your CV!



Stage 1: Training Session

During a three hour training session you will be introduced to what AU-T4T is all about. The first part consists of an introduction to the philosophy behind T4T. You will also learn about different education programs both within and outside of Auburn University that we currently run. During the second part, you are introduced to some of the education exercise currently within the program. In addition, we will cover some key points to keep in mind when preparing education exercises. Finally we play some of the games that are easily adjustable to a wide range of situations.

Stage 2: The AU-T4T assistant

Experience AU-T4T first hand, by assisting us in the many activities we organize. Education programs are just one part. To fund our program and to support tiger conservation in the wild, we organize fundraising activities. Join us for a total of three activities, with a minimum of one teaching activity to complete this stage.



Stage 3: Start roaring – Lead a teaching activity

You are ready now to go out all on your own. A T4T educator will be present to assist you, but the kids are all yours. Choose your program, select your activities, prepare the materials and enjoy!

Stage 4: Cub care – The AU-T4T Education Challenge

AU-T4T wouldn't exist without its educational activities. Many children enjoy the outreach programs so much that they return at every opportunity. They expect the same fun, the same great experience, but a different game, a different tale. Therefore, we need a wide variety of programs. To become an official member of the AU-T4T education crew, you are asked to develop one simple but fun educational exercise on Alabama wildlife or tiger conservation.
