The Auburn University Dietetic Internship has been granted full accreditation status from ACEND to enroll students who have earned a DPD verification statement. Program completers must fulfill all requirements for the M.S. degree in Nutrition to receive the program's Verification Statement, based on the ACEND-approved program requirements for the Auburn University Dietetic Internship. The Auburn University Dietetic Internship provides the needed supervised-practice hours within the curriculum to qualify for the RD exam upon graduation.</p> <p>State and federal facility regulations and state and federal statutes and regulations may specifically require or exempt licensure or an RDN credential to practice. Additionally, individual facilities may have their own standards beyond those based in law. Qualified nutrition practitioners are encouraged to consult their specific statutes and/or facility policies for clarification.</p>
