Degree certifications and ratings include FAA Private Pilot Certification, FAA Instrument Rating, FAA Commercial Pilot Certification, FAA Multi-Engine Rating, FAA Certified Flight Instructor (CFI), FAA CFI with Instrument Rating (CFII), and FAA Multi-Engine Instructor (MEI) Rating. The program meets educational requirements needed to obtain professional licensure at the federal level (there are no separate state licensure requirements).
