Management Discussion

FY 2023-24 Operating Budget Highlights

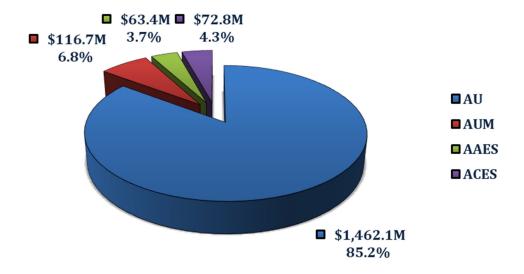


Figure 1: Auburn University Budget by Division for the Auburn University System

The proposed budget for FY 2023-24 is \$1.715 billion and is divided into the four budgetary divisions as illustrated in **Figure 1**. This budget has increased by \$122.3 million, or 7.68%, from the approved FY 2022-23 budget.

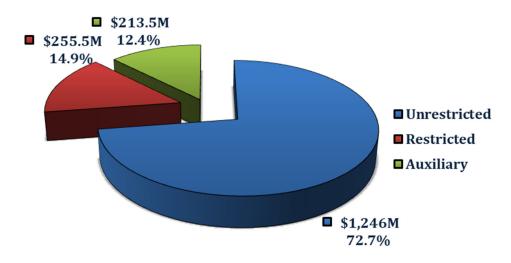


Figure 2: Auburn University Budget by Funding Category for the Auburn University System

The budget is grouped into three fund types for revenue and expenses based on certain characteristics of the sources and uses of the funds: unrestricted, restricted, and auxiliary. As shown in **Figure 2**, the majority of the University's funding falls into the unrestricted category.

Revenues

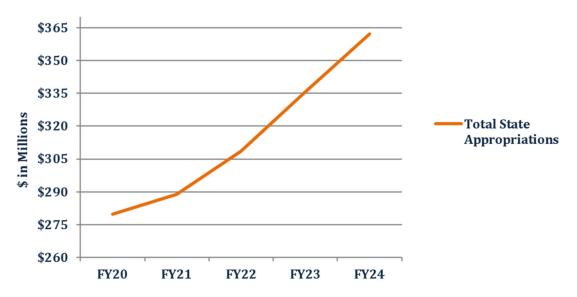


Figure 3: 5-Year Trend for State Appropriations for Auburn University

The 2023 legislative session concluded with another favorable outcome for Auburn University. *State appropriations* are expected to increase by \$26.4 million (7.9%) for FY 2023-24. Occasionally, Auburn receives supplemental appropriations for various projects and uses, and this legislative session was no different, with both Auburn-Main Campus and Auburn-Montgomery receiving a substantial allocation of resources from the supplemental pool. Because these funds are not recurring and amounts can vary, the only amounts included in the budget are those directly tied to Auburn in the Education Trust Fund appropriations bill. The trend for state appropriations continues to be extremely positive as seen in Figure 3 with a compound annual growth rate of 6.7% since FY20.

The Board of Trustees approved a tuition rate increase of 3% for Auburn-Main Campus and AUM for the FY 2023-24 academic year. The rate increase, coupled with an expectation of the largest freshman class in Auburn history, results in an increase in tuition and fees of \$36.6 million (5.1%) from the prior year. There are also increases in restricted revenues of \$26.7 million (11.7%) largely due to growth in research-related contracts and grants in the Colleges of Agriculture, Engineering and Sciences and Mathematics. Auxiliary revenues increased by \$15.9 million (8.7%). This is primarily due to increases in Athletics and Campus Living, which includes housing and dining. Other revenues increased by \$16.5 million (15.4%). This increase is related to the study abroad programs in several colleges, an increase in fees collected for the professional flight program due to increased enrollment, and an increase in indirect cost recovery revenues related to the aforementioned growth in contracts and grants revenue.

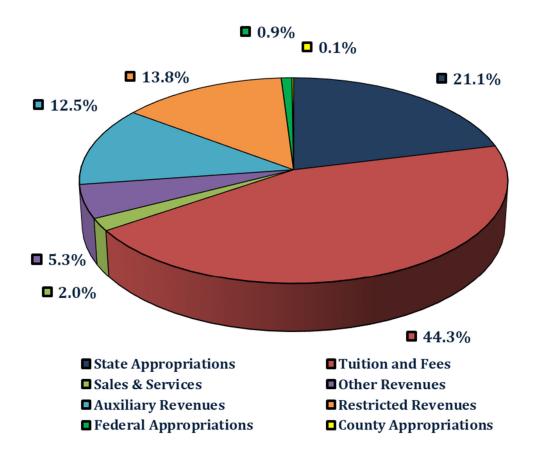


Figure 4: Total Revenue for the Auburn University System

The University has numerous revenue sources as seen in **Figure 4**. State appropriations and tuition & fees make up almost 65.4% of the total proposed budget for FY 2023-24, which is a slight decrease from the 66.5% they represented in FY 2022-23.

Expenses

The largest increase in expenses for the proposed budget is related to personnel costs with an overall \$66.9 million change (8.0%) from the prior year. The university is budgeting for a 3% merit pool which accounts for \$14.5 million of that increase. To continue the efforts of the prior year to improve market salaries for its staff and administrative & professional employees, Auburn University's leadership has committed additional funding of \$6.7 million in the FY24 budget to complete the second and final phase of the Mercer compensation study. The other increases in personnel costs are for job family and faculty promotions (\$1.8 million), new faculty and administrative positions (\$15.8 million) and other salary adjustments (\$12.3 million). Employee benefits increased by \$15.8 million from the prior year due to the increases in salaries and wages outlined above as well as a slight increase in the fringe benefit rate.

Excluding the Mission Enhancement Fund, total non-personnel expenses increased by \$55.0 million. The largest increase is in Student Aid (\$31.9 million) which includes additional funding due to projected acceptances for both merit- and need-based scholarships and graduate tuition waivers. Other areas of growth are in operations and maintenance costs of \$21.4 million, which includes increases on the contract for safety and security with the city of Auburn, contractual increases for administrative and academic software and infrastructure, and costs related to building operations on campus for square footage. This includes large increases due to inflation for utilities and campus maintenance contracts, as well as the addition of square footage on campus. For the first time in several years, the repair and renovation budget has been increased by approximately \$2 million. Debt service decreased slightly by approximately \$308 thousand due to the maturity of bonds that are tied to Athletics.

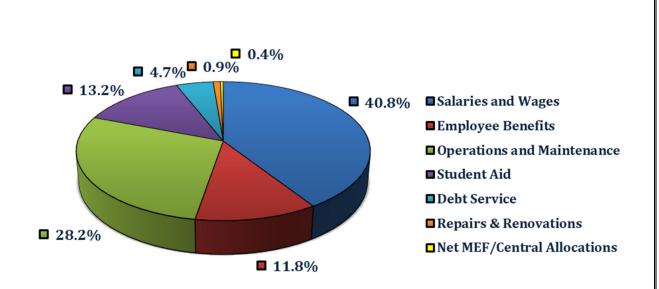


Figure 5: Expenses by Object for the Auburn University System

The University presents its expense budget in two major ways: by object and by function. There are four major categories used to identify expenses by object: Salaries and Wages, Employee Benefits, Operations and Maintenance, and Student Aid. The Operations and Maintenance category can also be broken into additional categories for: Debt Service, Repairs and Renovation, and Net Mission Enhancement Funding. The breakdown of expenses by object is illustrated with **Figure 5** on the following page.

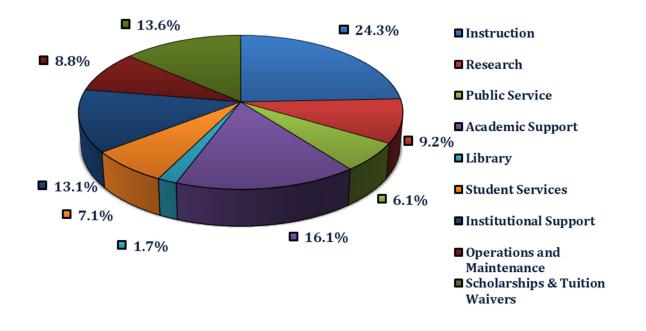


Figure 6: Expenses by Function for the Auburn University System

The University also budgets and records its expenses by function. The functional categories are meant to identify the purpose for the expense. **Figure 6**, on the following page, gives the breakdown by function for the University. The functional expense breakdown only includes unrestricted funds as restricted and auxiliary funds have multiple functional classifications that are not readily assignable to one of the categories.

Strategic Budgeting Initiative (SBI)

The proposed budget marks the third year of our second five-year cycle for the strategic budgeting initiative. Prior to development of the FY22 budget, various tweaks were made to the allocation percentages of our major revenue sources (state appropriations and net tuition), and those changes are still in effect for the FY24 budget. This includes: 1) a ratio of 65%/35% of undergraduate tuition allocated to the college of instruction and college of major, respectively, 2) a ratio of 90%/10% of graduate and professional tuition allocated to the college of major and college of instruction, respectively, and 3) a 65%/35% ratio of state appropriations allocated based on the amount of resident tuition allocated to revenue units and sponsored activity/research, respectively. The variables used for allocation continue to be based on the last full year of data, meaning there is a one-year lag for most model variables. The specific data points and percentages are on the tables in the Allocation Metrics section. Due to university re-organization and additional analysis of the units, some changes have been made to the cost allocation pools to better align the method of allocation with the function of the unit. Those specific pools can be found on the "Summary of Central Unit Expenses by Pool."

During the budget development cycle for FY 2023-24, the governance committees again played a part in building the proposed budget. The University Budget Advisory Committee continues to provide oversight for the budgeting process. Additionally, the committee serves in an advisory role to senior administration on high-level budgetary matters. Mission Enhancement Fund (MEF)

The MEF participation rate is 20% and is only assessed on allocated revenues. The funds generated are used for both subvention and strategic investment. For FY 2023-24, the amount generated in the MEF before reallocation is \$133 million. Subvention needs are approximately \$124.9 million, which yields a strategic investment portion of \$8.1 million. This represents a \$284K increase in the MEF from the prior year.

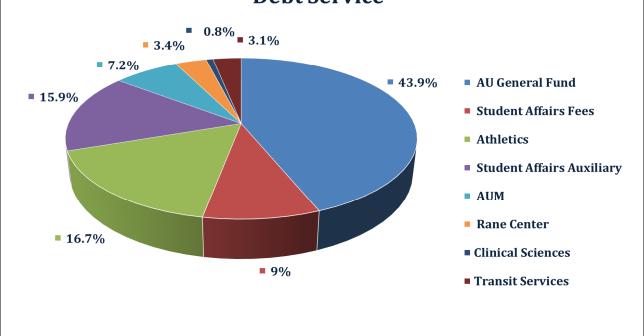

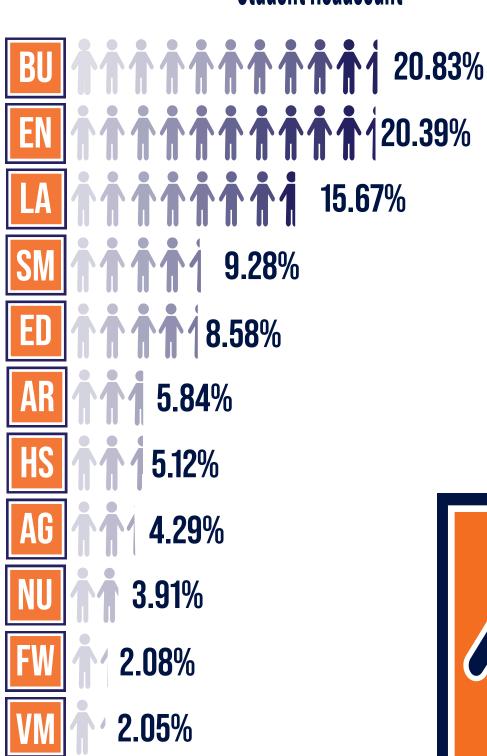

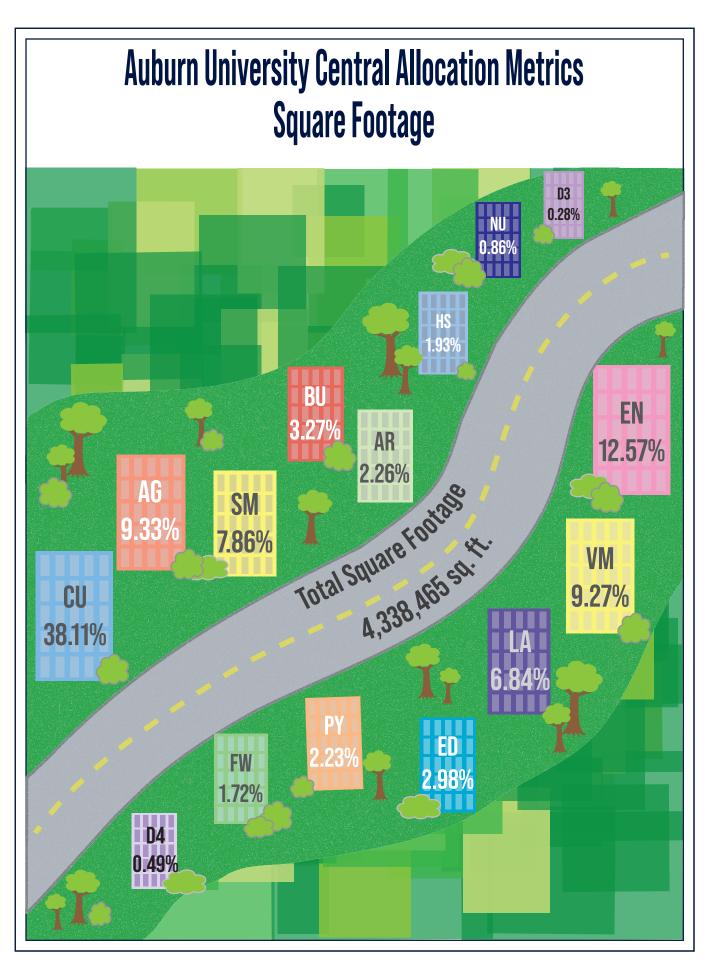
Auburn University Central Allocation Metrics Student Headcount

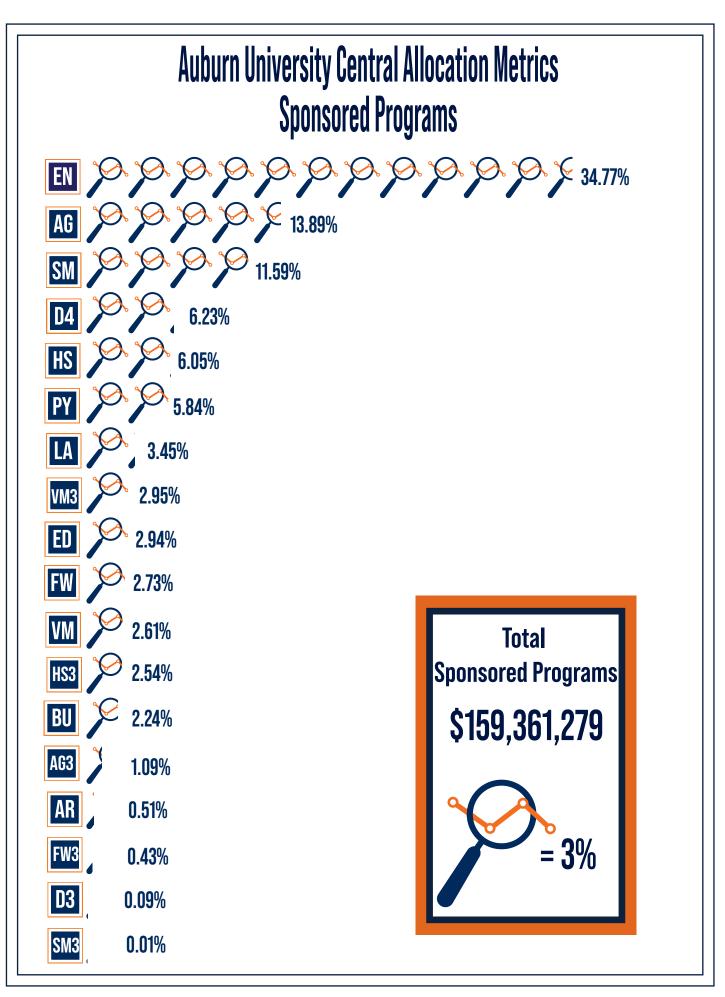
