Calendar Adjustment Resolution

WHEREAS, Auburn University's current academic calendar is restricted to be exactly seventy five class days, and;

WHEREAS, the seventy-five day academic calendar does not always allow two days between final exams and graduation, and seven days between graduation and the beginning of the next semester; and;

WHEREAS, this short time between semesters limits the ability of faculty to conduct research, prepare for the next semester, and lead students on international travel; Now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Calendar Committee be directed to construct a calendar for Fall and Spring Semesters of between seventy and seventy three class days and between forty-eight and forty-nine class days in the summer term.
