JOB SUMMARY

Reporting to the Sr Tech, GPAC Production or GPAC Production Manager, the Tech, GPAC Production supports the execution and coordination of a specific functional area—audio, lighting, or stage operations—contributing to the success of productions at the Jay & Susie Gogue Performance Arts Center (GPAC). This entry-level position involves learning and actively participating in various technical aspects of production.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Learn the intricacies of a specific production area (audio, lighting, or stage operations) under the guidance of the Sr Tech or Production Manager. Actively participate in training sessions to enhance technical skills.
- Assist in the setup and operation of equipment for productions, ensuring adherence to high-quality standards. Provide support to senior techs and production team members as required.
- Collaborate with the production team to ensure effective communication and coordination. Assist in meeting the technical requirements of visiting workforce and user groups.
- Contribute to the welfare of operational systems and specifications for the facility. Assist in inventory management, storage, and basic maintenance of tools and equipment.
- Adhere to health and safety protocols within the respective functional area. Report any safety concerns or issues promptly to the Sr Tech or Production Manager.
- Provide support during presenting and rental contract negotiations, demonstrating a commitment to excellent customer service.
- Update the Sr Tech or Production Manager on the status of tasks and responsibilities regularly.
- Assist in interpreting and executing technical requests under supervision.

The responsibilities listed above show the typical duties for jobs in this classification. Actual tasks may differ depending on the department's needs. Other similar duties may be assigned with discretion of the supervisor. Not every duty will apply to every position, and the amount of time spent on each task can change based on department needs.
