JOB SUMMARY

Provides curatorial management for the University to include maintaining collections and databases.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Identifies, accessions, catalogues, maintains, preserves, restores and disposes of collections.
- Creates and maintains databases, field notes, and other associated records and documentation.
- Builds and improves collections.
- Provides public tours and assists teachers, students and visiting researchers.
- Assists faculty, executives, study teams and student groups with projects.
- Obtains funding for collections operation.
- May prepare manuscripts for submission to journals.
- May coordinate and oversee the maintenance of facilities and grounds.

The responsibilities listed above show the typical duties for jobs in this classification. Actual tasks may differ depending on the department's needs. Other similar duties may be assigned with discretion of the supervisor. Not every duty will apply to every position, and the amount of time spent on each task can change based on department needs.
