JOB SUMMARY

Provides counseling and psychological services for students and provides information regarding mental health services and programs.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provides counseling to students to include, but not limited to, individual counseling, group counseling, family consultations, and crisis referral.
- Plans, develops, and/or presents informational programs related to mental health concerns and available services.
- Documents, reports on, and/or maintains confidential records and evaluation information from counseling/program sessions.
- Evaluates and develops comprehensive treatment plans for individuals to include (but not limited to) assessing, diagnosing, coordinating treatments with other professionals, and/or providing referrals.
- May supervise and/or train non-licensed graduate student clinicians.

The responsibilities listed above show the typical duties for jobs in this classification. Actual tasks may differ depending on the department's needs. Other similar duties may be assigned with discretion of the supervisor. Not every duty will apply to every position, and the amount of time spent on each task can change based on department needs.
