JOB SUMMARY

Assists in the direction and coordination of clinical services and programs for students.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provides oversight for all clinical service components including individual therapy, group therapy, case management, psychological testing, and specialty services.
- Maintains a client caseload to include crisis assessment and response, individual and group psychotherapy, clinical consultation, outreach programming, and clinical supervision.
- Maintains and develops policies and procedures to ensure best clinical practices, applicable state and federal statutes, local health and safety laws and regulations, risk management policies, and professional code of ethics.
- Coordinates the clinical staffing committees and is responsive to clinical services as they arise.
- Serves as the point person for all incoming clinical concerns, requests for records, and consultation with contracted psychiatrists and community mental health providers as needed for the coordination of care.
- Provides leadership in the center's outcome assessment efforts and quality assurance.
- Manages projects in areas of responsibility to include design, implementation, and evaluation.

The responsibilities listed above show the typical duties for jobs in this classification. Actual tasks may differ depending on the department's needs. Other similar duties may be assigned with discretion of the supervisor. Not every duty will apply to every position, and the amount of time spent on each task can change based on department needs.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES
