JOB SUMMARY

Directs, organizes, and evaluates all work aspects of the multi-phases of competition athletics turf and/or practice facilities and all aspects of landscape services for athletics facilities.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Directs the daily operation of the athletic turf management program and grounds for Auburn University.
- Develops and implements turf grass programs, and researches and partners with other university programs to provide the best possible competition and practice facilities.
- Designs and directs irrigation and pesticide programs in partnership with university agencies.
- Develops and oversee programs designed to address and minimize excessive turf wear and loss.
- Develops, organizes, and manages the turf equipment program.
- Prepares, develops and manages the department budgets for turf grass and landscape services.
- Complies with all applicable National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) and Southeastern Conference (SEC) regulations in the performance of job duties.

The responsibilities listed above show the typical duties for jobs in this classification. Actual tasks may differ depending on the department's needs. Other similar duties may be assigned with discretion of the supervisor. Not every duty will apply to every position, and the amount of time spent on each task can change based on department needs.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES
