JOB SUMMARY

Trains raptors for presentation in public exhibitions for educational purposes.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conducts raptor educational programs to include teaching, public speaking, and providing expertise and assistance in outreach efforts.
- Trains and manages raptor collection and collect, analyze, record and compile samples and data.
- Provides raptor husbandry.
- Provides public relations for Auburn University and respond to public inquiry about raptors.
- Maintains raptor handling equipment.
- Schedules and collects fees for educational programs.
