JOB SUMMARY

Responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of the 415-acre Crooked Oaks property, including homes, a pavilion, a barn, ponds, and roadways, as well as working with the tree nursery and supervising student groundworkers. Coordinates hunting leases, sets up for events, and assists with history tours on Coach Pat Dye and the property.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Oversees the maintenance and care of the Crooked Oaks facilities, property, and land, which encompasses 415 acres, two homes, a pavilion, a barn, three ponds, and roadways.
- Maintains the tree nursery and activities such as care and maintenance of trees, the sale of trees, and regular maintenance of the nursery.
- Oversees and supervises student groundworkers on the property.
- Coordinates and monitors outside parties that have hunting leases on the property to ensure they are following safety protocols. Lessees hunt quail and white-tailed deer in the designated hunting areas.
- Assists with tours and provides extensive history and background related to Coach Pat Dye and the Crooked Oaks property.
- Sets up and tear down of tables, chairs, pavilion walls, etc. for AU classes and outside events.

The responsibilities listed above show the typical duties for jobs in this classification. Actual tasks may differ depending on the department's needs. Other similar duties may be assigned with discretion of the supervisor. Not every duty will apply to every position, and the amount of time spent on each task can change based on department needs.
