JOB SUMMARY

Responsible for supervising a team of employees performing routine animal care for a variety of large and farm animal species.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Supervises and participates in the daily animal care operations and maintenance of an animal care and holding complex for a variety of large and farm animal species that supports veterinary medicine teaching, research, and treatment programs. Assigns tasks and ensures work is performed appropriately.
- Informs manager or department head of work progress, present and potential problems, and makes suggestions for new or improved ways of addressing problems.
- Assists the director in planning and deciding protocols pertaining to the facilities, supplies, animal health or care operations, and employees.

The responsibilities listed above show the typical duties for jobs in this classification. Actual tasks may differ depending on the department's needs. Other similar duties may be assigned with discretion of the supervisor. Not every duty will apply to every position, and the amount of time spent on each task can change based on department needs.
