JOB SUMMARY

Performs and oversees rehabilitation services provided to canine patients of the Auburn University College of Veterinary Medicine.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Formulates and executes patient treatment plans, including ongoing reevaluation of care and communication of discharge plans with caretakers.
- Performs, instructs, and demonstrates canine rehabilitation procedures and techniques.
- Consults with veterinarians regarding rehabilitation treatment plans for patients.
- Operates and maintains equipment and facilities used in the rehabilitation of patients.
- Performs documentation and charting for patients receiving rehabilitation treatment.
- May perform medical examinations, laboratory testing, or administer medications to patients.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES

Supervisory Responsibility

May be responsible for training, assisting or assigning tasks to others. May provide input to performance reviews of other employees.
