### JOB SUMMARY

The Registered Radiation Therapist is responsible for accurate delivery of radiation therapy for small and large animal patients under the direction of the Radiation Oncologist. In addition, through documentation and oral communication, the Radiation Therapist shares and coordinates key information with other members of the healthcare team. Assists the team with development of new techniques for the delivery of radiation therapy to small animals and large animals.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provides radiation therapy services and CT simulations for radiation therapy patients. Reviews prescription, diagnosis, patient chart, and identification. Evaluates cone beam CT images, evaluates portal radiographs, and ensures treatment plan matches prescriptions. Prepares equipment such as immobilization, treatment, and protection devices, positions patient according to prescription. Enters data into computer and sets controls to operate equipment. Observes and reassures patient during treatment and reports unusual reactions to physician. Photographs treated area of patient. Maintains records, reports, and files as required. Follows principles of radiation protection for patient, self, and others.
- Assists with research projects in radiation oncology and/or radiology. Assists the radiation oncologist and/or radiologist in carrying out radiation therapy on patients, setting up treatment protocols, collecting therapy data, and collecting follow up data on response to treatments.
- Assists with radiography and CT scans in the department as time allows. This position may be called upon to perform radiographs and computed tomography scans of patients in the Bailey Small Animal Teaching Hospital.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
