JOB SUMMARY

Assists in the management of the daily building support operations of a facility or multiple facilities to include supervising and assigning work, overseeing custodial care, minor maintenance, facilities, and meeting room arrangements and audio visual support.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Inspects all areas of the building(s) for cleanliness, orderliness, safety, ease of passage, and aesthetic quality.
- Assists with major event planning, facilitation, day-to-day room set up and audio visual needs, and clean up.
- Identifies and resolves maintenance problems throughout the building(s) either by performing minor maintenance work or coordinating work with facilities staff.
- Responsible for monitoring and maintaining the supply budget.
- Purchases, collects, stores, and distributes supplies and equipment.
- Communicates with others to keep them informed of work progress, respond to complaints and answer questions.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES

Supervisory Responsibility

Full supervisory responsibility for other employees is a major responsibility and includes training, evaluating, and making or recommending pay, promotion or other employment decisions.
