JOB SUMMARY

Under direct supervision, assists in the removal/installation process of campus-wide signage such as building monuments and lettering, door directories, and vinyl sign creations. Assists in the removal/installation of sign poles of various styles and sizes. Assists in the maintenance, removal, and installation of parking lot, crosswalks, and street paint markings.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assists in the creation of signage using equipment such as vinyl plotter, engraver, and flat-bed printers.
- Assists in the installation of signage to monument signs, door directories, building exteriors, street signage, and coroplast sheeting.
- Assists on removing and installation of sign poles and banners campus-wide.
- Assists in preparing and installation of street marking paint on roadways and parking lots.
- May assist with pressure washing sidewalks and parking lots on campus.
- Demonstrate the basic abilities to use hand and power tools such as post hole digger, augur, shovel, drill, leaf blower, etc.
- Demonstrates a basic understanding of ADA standards and regulations pertaining to interior signage and parking lot signage as well as parking lot spacing.

The responsibilities listed above show the typical duties for jobs in this classification. Actual tasks may differ depending on the department's needs. Other similar duties may be assigned with discretion of the supervisor. Not every duty will apply to every position, and the amount of time spent on each task can change based on department needs.
