JOB SUMMARY

The Communications Writer & Editor III is responsible for writing, editing, and delivering high-impact editorial content that advances the university's strategic priorities, strengthens its national reputation, and reinforces a distinct institutional brand. This role blends storytelling excellence with strategic judgment, translating complex academic, research, and institutional initiatives into compelling narratives for broad internal and external audiences.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Leads the development, writing, and editing of high-impact stories and features that advance the university's strategic priorities and national reputation.
- Translates highly complex or high-profile academic, research, and institutional initiatives into compelling narratives for broad audiences.
- Sets story framing, messaging, and narrative direction to support institutional goals and brand positioning.
- Directs planning, production, editing, and deadlines for complex editorial and multimedia projects.
- Strategically pitches, places, and positions stories through public relations and media monitoring platforms.
- Serves as a key collaborator and advisor to campus partners on narrative development and content positioning.
- Ensures consistent application of Auburn's voice, tone, and messaging across platforms.
- Contributes to and oversees web and digital content to ensure quality, accuracy, and alignment.

The responsibilities listed above show the typical duties for jobs in this classification. Actual tasks may differ depending on the department's needs. Other similar duties may be assigned with discretion of the supervisor. Not every duty will apply to every position, and the amount of time spent on each task can change based on department needs.
