JOB SUMMARY

This role leads the strategic planning, development, and execution of social media efforts across the department or assigned portfolios, aligning channel strategies with institutional priorities, goals, and audiences. The position serves as a subject-matter expert, guiding campus partners while ensuring consistency, effectiveness, and measurable impact.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Leads the development and implementation of social media strategies that align with university objectives, brand positioning, and audience engagement goals.
- Establishes and maintains scalable systems, standards, and best practices for content planning, publishing, and governance across campus.
- Oversees editorial planning and content direction for assigned initiatives, ensuring cohesive storytelling and strategic alignment across platforms.
- Partners with campus stakeholders to integrate social media into broader marketing, communications, and engagement efforts, providing strategic consultation and guidance.
- Analyzes social media performance data and trends, translating analytics into actionable insights and recommendations to improve effectiveness and reach.
- Leads the planning and execution of campaigns, including organic and paid social efforts, audience targeting, performance optimization, and post-campaign evaluation.
- May guide and review content produced by staff, interns, student employees, or ambassadors to ensure quality, consistency, and adherence to institutional standards.
- Serves as a resource for emerging platforms, tools, and social media trends, proactively advising on opportunities and risks.
- Contributes to crisis communication preparedness and response for social media channels in coordination with appropriate university offices.
- Develops and delivers reporting, documentation, and presentations that communicate outcomes, insights, and strategic value to leadership and stakeholders.

The responsibilities listed above show the typical duties for jobs in this classification. Actual tasks may differ depending on the department's needs. Other similar duties may be assigned with discretion of the supervisor. Not every duty will apply to every position, and the amount of time spent on each task can change based on department needs.
