How does my four-year scholarship work with my five year co-op schedule?

Four-year scholarships awarded by the Office of University Scholarships are available for eight semesters. When you participate in a co-op program, the end term for your scholarship is extended each semester that you are working until you have used all eight semesters of your scholarship as an undergraduate student.

Do I need to notify your office when I co-op and when I return?

Our office routinely generates reports of students who are participating in co-op each semester, and we automatically adjust scholarships accordingly, so there is no need to notify us when you co-op or when you return. We will send an email to your Auburn email address when your scholarship is adjusted.

What happens to my scholarship if I co-op two semesters in a row?

If you co-op two semesters in a row, please contact our office to complete a Request for Non-Payment form.

How does my co-op schedule affect the renewal requirements for my scholarship?

The tables below show a typical co-op schedule along with what our office will review in determining your eligibility for renewal of your scholarship for the following academic year.

Am I required to enroll during the summer?

Yes, during your co-op schedule there will be a year where it will be necessary to attend school during the summer to stay on course to renew your scholarship. Just like during any other semester, you must enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours for your scholarship to pay.
